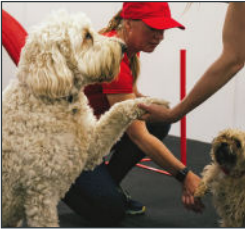




Teenage Tearaway?

With the huge success of our puppy socialisation and training sessions we have created *Norman's Dog Day Care Youth Club* to assist with dogs aged between 6 months and 2 years.

Let's talk about the science behind this: we realised that there is a gap between the ages of 6 months and 2 years old where your beloved puppy can go through some acute development phases.

Did you know?

- from **4 to 8 months** a puppy play instinct kicks in. This is a critical time, as dog owners may find their puppy wandering and being more prone to selective hearing. During this period our trainers will help focus on the all-important aspects of *recognition, recall* and *boundaries* which are vitally important at this stage.
- Between the ages of **6 and 14 months** your puppy will embark on a second fear phase where they will show fear of new situations. This phase can also manifest itself as a fear of new dogs, people and unfamiliar environments. Here at Norman's we can help talk and walk you through how we work through this phase with your puppy.
- **1 to 4 Years** Maturity Period: you may encounter some increased and renewed testing for position and authority. This is also coupled with another fear period between the ages of 12 and 18 months which is a particularly challenging time – going back to basics is sometimes needed to help you through this phase, with some really fun training elements to step up your training outside.

We offer morning and afternoon training packages. We have set up sessions from Monday through to Friday from 8.00am to 12 noon or 12.30pm to 4.30pm. A temperament test is required before admission to these sessions: please enquire so that we can arrange this.
